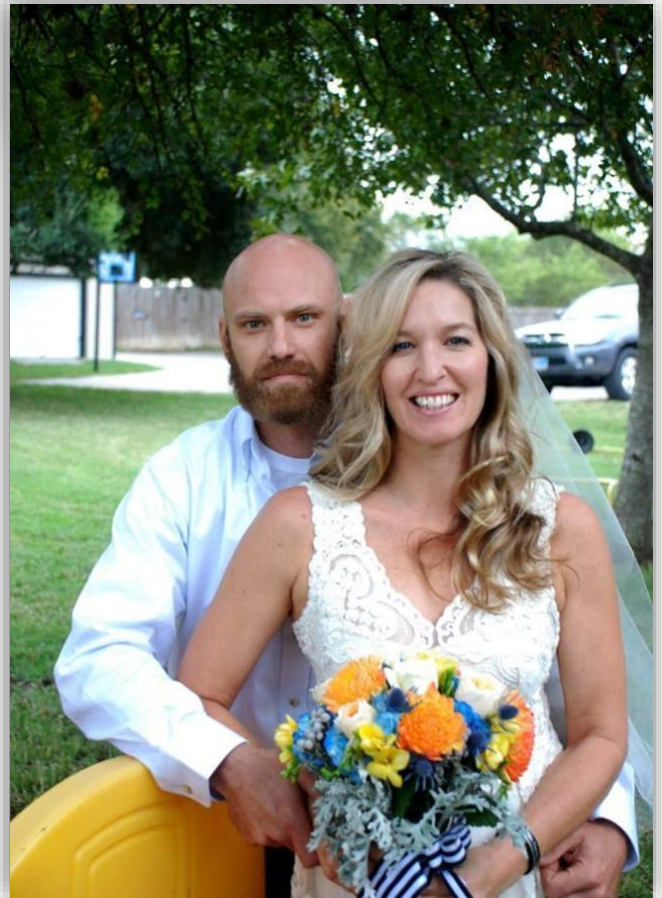

# our journey.

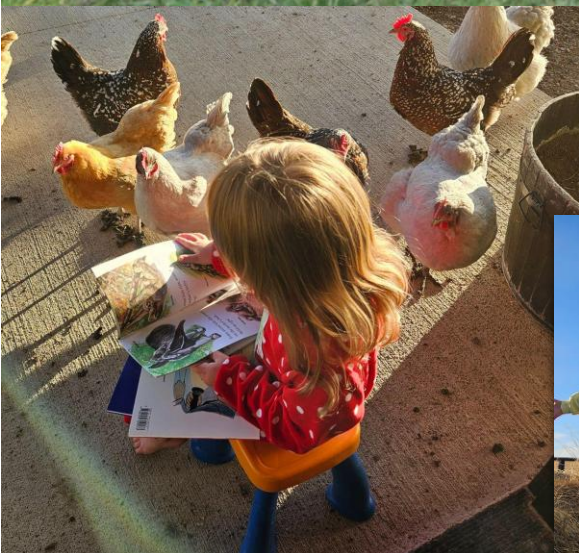
